







## DAILY LIVING SUPPORTS

The main focus for all our clinics is providing the individual speech pathology, occupational therapy and psychology services that you choose to help your child learn and develop as best they can to achieve their goals. In each of our disciplines, we can provide:

- **Assessment:** The starting point is having a comprehensive understanding of your child's strengths and challenges then we know how best to help them.
- **Therapy :** We set smaller goals that we work towards each and every session using evidence based practices.
- **Specialised Group Early Interventions:** For children aged 0-6 years old.
- **Group Therapy:** For Social Skills, Fine Motor Skills, Sensory Motor Skills, Handwriting, Life Skills, Play Skills and School Readiness
- **Therapy Assistant:** Following a program set and supervised by our therapists.
- **Allied Health Students:** University students on placements providing services at 50% of the cost
- **Training for Carers/Parents:** Assisting you to develop skills such as in our Key Word Sign Basic Workshops, Hanen Parent Training Programs or a tailored workshop to meet you or your child's needs
- **Training in Assistive Technology;** Assisting the child, carers and parents understand how to use assistive technology.
- **Plan Review:** Preparing a report for you at the end of each plan that summarises the child's achievements against their goals and give recommendations.

Our Psychologist, Dr Karen Plant can assist with the provision of specialist behaviour support intervention and provide behaviour management support training to parents, carers and educators.
